

Modern Slavery Statement UK Gov Registration

Please see section 1 for how to register your organisation with the home office and get the process started.

Section 2 is very self-explanatory and explores basic information on the organisation and it's statement.

Section 3 provides guidance on how to answer specific modern slavery and human rights questions however please note that this is just an **example**, and the risks posed to each business may differ according to the vendors they are working with. ***Please answer the questions according to the specific measures taken and risks posed to your organisation.***

Section 1
